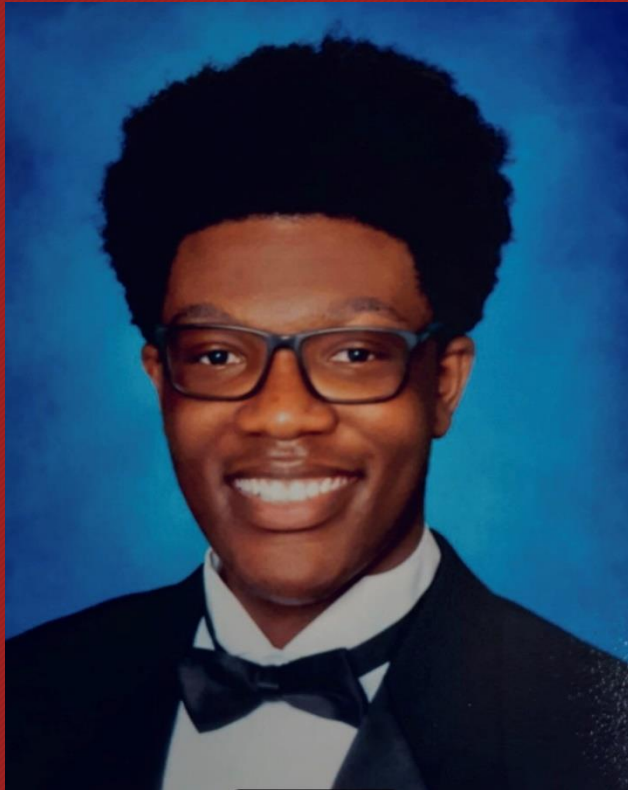


# Alexander White
